NOTES ON TASCC TASCC was formed for cultural, educational, scientific and trade purposes which promote mutually beneficial relationships between the people of the City of Tucson, Arizona, USA and the people of the City of Almaty, Kazakhstan. TASCC exists based on a resolution passed by the Tucson City Council and an agreement signed by the Mayor of Tucson and the Mayor of Alma-Ata (now Almaty) on June 2, 1989. The operating authority of TASCC derives from the articles of incorporation and bylaws of the Sister Cities Association of Tucson. Bylaws are in effect that clearly state the purpose of this committee and the rules by which it conducts the business and affairs of the committee. TASCC operates under the Arizona Open Meeting Law and follows Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised. Elections are held annually and the chairperson can only serve two years in succession. The fiscal year of TASCC is July 1 thru June 30 of each year. Meetings are held monthly on the third Wednesday at a place and time to be determined by the chairperson.
